Four years ago our Fellowship made a big difference in the lives of two young refugees from Burundi. Together we donated some \$40,000 to sponsor them to immigrate to Canada.



They came, they settled, they studied, they worked, and this spring they are in the process for receiving their Canadian Citizenship.

Our goal in 2021 is to raise \$10,000 to support 28 Burundian refugees, members and friends of the Unitarian Church of Burundi.

In 2015 political violence broke out in Burundi causing over 400,000 people to flee the country. These 28 were among them, as was the minister of their church and the two young men we sponsored in 2017.

In the crackdown on political dissent, the Unitarian Church was attacked and the minister, the Rev. Fulgence Ndajigamana, arrested, jailed and tortured. An advocacy campaign led by the International Council of Unitarians and Universalists secured Rev. Fulgence's release. He fled Burundi, became a refugee and eventually came to Canada.

Once settled in Canada, Rev. Fulgence set out to help his parishoners

and countrymen now stranded as refugees in the countries surrounding Burundi. He founded FLAMING CHALICE INTERNATIONAL https://www.flaminginternational.org/ to raise financial support for their aid.

- a mother and father with one child in the city of Ruhengeri, Rwanda (Funds are for basic needs, and to help the mother start a small business).
- a group of six young men, and another group of three, sharing accommodations in Kigali, Rwanda; some of these young men had service jobs around the city but these ended with the pandemic outbreak. (Funds are for accommodation and basic needs).
- a mother in Ruhengeri studying to complete her university degree in Biomedical Laboratory Sciences. To attend university she had to leave the Mahama Camp where she had found refuge with her husband and daughter. (Funds are for the cost of her studies).

- three young men living in Gisenyi in Rwanda. FCI had supported them with scholarships. They are now trying to survive on their own and want to start a small business. (Funds are start-up for the small business)
- two young men living together in Nairobi (Funds are for accommodation and basic needs)
